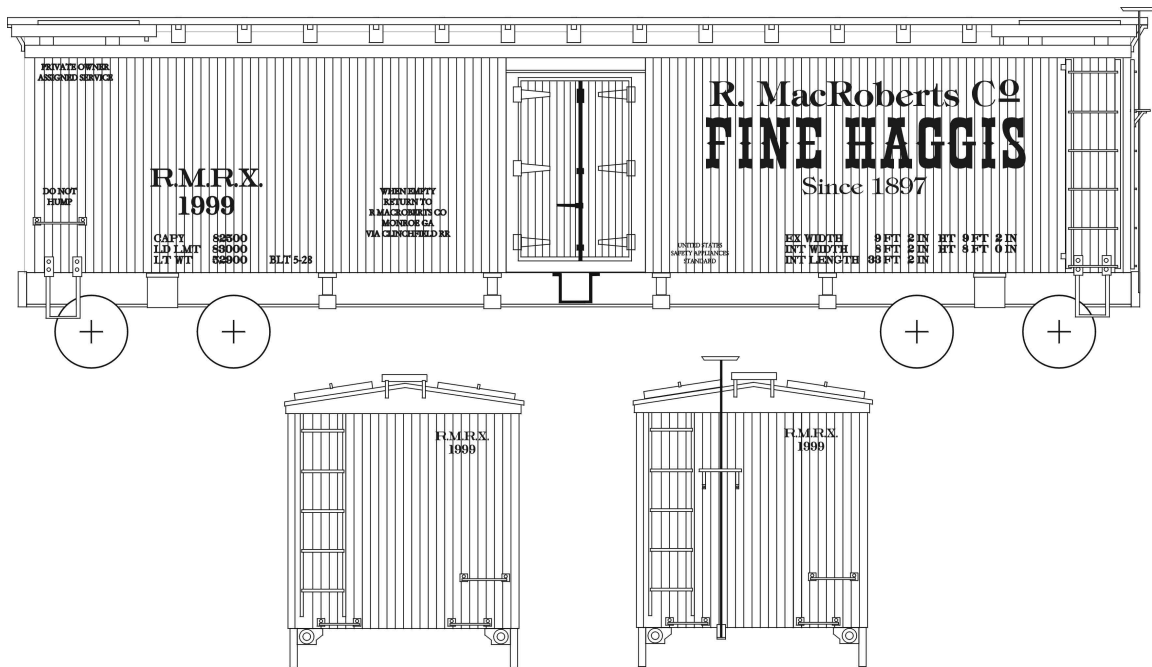


THE HAGGIS DECAL PROJECT

This may account for the variety of paint schemes they are reported to have worn. The only common traits seem to be a light-colored car body, with a darker-colored roof.
